A significant case I've worked on:

One of the most exciting cases in recent years would be the criminal defence of a commodity trading company in the frame of alleged bribery payments made to African public officials. The case involved various interesting legal aspects such as internal investigations, international mutual legal assistance in criminal matters and compliance issues. Considering the sensitive topic, the defence work also had to focus on the reputational impacts of the case and the related media communication. A complex negotiation had to be initiated with the criminal authorities. Indeed, a very comprehensive range of expertise had to be put at the disposal of the client.
